Our old art and craft room has served us well since the 1980s. But it is near the end of its life. Four Seasons Studio is our vision for a multipurpose building to replace it.

The Vision

Even before deciding on specific design options, we knew the main points of the building we were aiming for.

- A resource for groups and individuals in the local community, as well as Othona's residential visitors.
- Extremely adaptable, combining good facilities for arts and crafts, bodywork, creative play and other educational activities.
- Considerably larger and equipped with a kitchen and toilets, unlike its predecessor.
- Fully accessible and built to high environmental standards, minimising its carbon footprint.
- An inspiration in itself to the would-be artist or visiting retreatant, in tune with its stunning natural surroundings.

The Funding

The project has already attracted funding from one grant-making trust and many individual donors. The estimated budget for completion is £200,000. So we are looking to raise up to a further £90,000.
